T1.1 TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

Umgeni Water is a state owned business enterprise and it operates within the South African legislative parameters of the Water Services Act 108 of 1997, Public Finance Management Act 1 of 1999 and Public Audit Act 25 of 2004.

Competent and experienced service providers are invited to tender for the following:

SUPPLY, DELIVERY AND OFFLOADING OF POLYMERIC COAGULANTS FOR UMGENI WATER COASTAL REGION – NORTHERN AREA FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS

In addition to the Eligibility Criteria specified in Clause F2.1 of the tender document, tenderers are required to fulfil the following:

- achieve at least 35% Contract Participation Goals (CPG) including a minimum 5% Black Women Participation of the value of goods, services and Works paid to one or more targeted enterprises to comply with Umgeni Water's BBEE policy initiative.
- Submit proof of Assurance for the Supply of Polymeric Coagulants from the Manufacturer to the Distributor must be signed by the relevant authorised official - This is applicable only if the tenderer is not the manufacturer.
- Valid Certificate - the polymeric coagulant/flocculant product must be NSF/ANSI 60 certified.
- The tenderer shall supply 2 x 500ml well-sealed samples at the time of closure of tender.
- Polymeric coagulant solution should not contain heavy metals concentrations above limits specified on SANS 241:2015 and the coagulant should be able to achieve ≤ 5 NTU for Clarified Water and ≤ 0.5 NTU for Filtered Water to be considered further.

Evaluation method:

The tender will firstly be evaluated on eligibility. If found to be eligible, it will be further evaluated in two stages i.e.

- Functionality shall be assessed. A minimum functionality score of **70 points** is required for the tender to be considered further.
- Price & Preference using the **80/20** Preference Point Scoring System in terms of PPPFA.
